

LEADGEN AWARDS GUIDELINES

1. Scholarship levels are flexible and are at the sole discretion of the Committee.
2. Scholarship payments will be made to the school, church or agency – not to the applicant.
3. Scholarship ranges outlined on promotional materials are intended to reflect annual amounts.
4. Applications are due eight weeks prior to commencement of the subject program. Late applications will be considered on a case by case basis, subject to availability of funds.
5. Scholarships will not be given for District licensing requirements, but are intended to help train up new leaders.
6. “Membership” is intended to mean “formal membership” as generally understood in MB churches.
7. This is a U.S. Program and applicants need to be residents of the U.S. and pursuing a U.S.-based program or ministry.
8. If applicant is attending a non-MB seminary, the application will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
9. While LG is designed to encourage young people along the path of becoming an MB pastor or missionary, we also think there is value in helping current pastors sharpen their leadership skills. To that end, pastoral degrees like an M Div or MA will be considered, but not PHDs or other, nontraditional, pastoral education experiences.
