



## FIRSTFRUITS REFERENCES (all references are NIV unless otherwise stated)

1. **Exodus 23:16**  
Celebrate the Feast of Harvest with the **firstfruits** of the crops you sow in your field. Celebrate the Feast of Ingathering at the end of the year, when you gather in your crops from the field.
2. **Exodus 23:19**  
Bring the best of the **firstfruits** of your soil to the house of the LORD your God. Do not cook a young goat in its mother's milk.
3. **Exodus 34:22**  
Celebrate the Feast of Weeks with the **firstfruits** of the wheat harvest, and the Feast of Ingathering at the turn of the year.
4. **Exodus 34:26**  
Bring the best of the **firstfruits** of your soil to the house of the LORD your God. Do not cook a young goat in its mother's milk.
5. **Leviticus 2:12**  
You may bring them to the LORD as an offering of the **firstfruits**, but they are not to be offered on the altar as a pleasing aroma.
6. **Leviticus 2:14**  
If you bring a grain offering of **firstfruits** to the LORD, offer crushed heads of new grain roasted in the fire.
7. **Leviticus 23:9-10**  
The LORD said to Moses, Speak to the Israelites and say to them: When you enter the land I am going to give you and you reap its harvest, bring to the priest a sheaf of the **first** grain you harvest.
8. **Leviticus 23:17**  
From wherever you live, bring two loaves made of two-tenths of an ephah of fine flour, baked with yeast, as a wave offering of **firstfruits** to the LORD.

9. **Leviticus 23:20**  
The priest is to wave the two lambs before the LORD as a wave offering, together with the bread of the **firstfruits**. They are a sacred offering to the LORD for the priest.
10. **Numbers 18:12**  
I give you all the finest olive oil and all the finest new wine and grain they give the LORD as the **firstfruits** of their harvest.
11. **Numbers 18:13**  
All the land's **firstfruits** that they bring to the LORD will be yours. Everyone in your household who is ceremonially clean may eat it.
12. **Numbers 28:26**  
On the day of **firstfruits**, when you present to the LORD an offering of new grain during the Feast of Weeks, hold a sacred assembly and do no regular work.
13. **Deuteronomy 18:4**  
You are to give them the **firstfruits** of your grain, new wine and oil, and the first wool from the shearing of your sheep,
14. **Deuteronomy 26:1-2**  
When you have entered the land the LORD your God is giving you as an inheritance and have taken possession of it and settled in it, take some of the **firstfruits** of all that you produce from the soil of the land the LORD your God is giving you and put them in a basket. Then go to the place the LORD you God will choose as a dwelling for his Name
15. **Deuteronomy 26:10**  
and now I bring the **firstfruits** of the soil that you, O LORD, have given me. Place the basket before the LORD your God and bow down before him.
16. **2 Chronicles 31:5**  
As soon as the order went out, the Israelites generously gave the **firstfruits** of their grain, new wine, oil and honey and all that the fields produced. They brought a great amount, a tithe of everything.
17. **Nehemiah 10:35**  
We also assume responsibility for bringing to the house of the LORD each year the **firstfruits** of our crops and of every fruit tree.
18. **Nehemiah 12:44**  
At that time men were appointed to be in charge of the storerooms for the contributions, **firstfruits** and tithes. From the fields around the towns they were to bring into the storerooms the portions required by the Law for the priests and the Levites, for Judah was



pleased with the ministering priests and Levites.

19. **Nehemiah 13:31**

I also made provision for contributions of wood at designated times, and for the **firstfruits**. Remember me with favor, O my God.

20. **Psalms 78:51**

He struck down all the firstborn of Egypt, the **firstfruits** of manhood in the tents of Ham.

21. **Psalms 105:36**

Then he struck down all the firstborn in their land, the **firstfruits** of all their manhood.

22. **Proverbs 3:9**

Honor the LORD with your wealth, with the **firstfruits** of all your crops; (NIV)

Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce. (NLT)

Honor the LORD from your wealth and from the first of all your produce; (NASB)

Honor God with everything you own; give him the first and the best. (MSG)

23. **Jeremiah 2:3**

Israel was holy to the LORD, the **firstfruits** of his harvest; all who devoured her were held guilty, and disaster overtook them, declares the LORD.

24. **Ezekiel 44:30**

The best of all the **firstfruits** and of all your special gifts will belong to the priests. You are to give them the first portion of your ground meal so that a blessing may rest on your household.

25. **Romans 8:23**

Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the **firstfruits** of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for our adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies.

26. **Romans 11:16**

If the part of the dough offered as **firstfruits** is holy, then the whole batch is holy; if the root is holy, so are the branches.

27. **1 Corinthians 15:20**

But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the **firstfruits** of those who have fallen asleep.



28. **1 Corinthians 15:23**

But each in his own turn: Christ, the **firstfruits**; then, when he comes, those who belong to him.

29. **James 1:18**

He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of **firstfruits** of all he created.

30. **Revelation 14:4**

These are those who did not defile themselves with women, for they kept themselves pure. They follow the Lamb wherever he goes. They were purchased from among men and offered as **firstfruits** to God and the Lamb.
